Sansone’s Farm Market Co-op

I. Membership Options

Note: ALL members, regardless of level, will receive an additional 5% discount on all of our conventional produce, and will be eligible to purchase produce from our weekly “Member Specials,” when available. Specials will change each week depending on what is in season.

- a. Option 1 – **Harvest Member:** \$50 membership fee earns you the ability to pick your own produce in our designated insecticide-free field. You then pay for what you pick at 10% discount off retail price of the insecticide-free produce. If you do not wish to pick your own produce at any time, you may purchase produce from our Member Specials and receive your discount on the produce in our store.
- b. Option 2 – **Heirloom Member:** No membership fee. You hold a pre-paid tab with us and get bonus money up front depending on the level of prepayment. When your balance runs out, you can reload. Balance can be used during any season, on anything at our farm (excluding services such as landscaping, mulch delivery, etc). **Must be used before the end of the calendar year** (December 24th is our last day open for business).

- c. Option 3 – **Mixed Basket Member:** Combination of Options 1 & 2. You pay for your selected pre-paid amount + the \$50 membership fee (½ of membership fee [\$25] is applied to your starting balance on your pre-paid account). You get the 10% discount off retail when you pick your own; your pre-paid bonus money is applied to your starting balance. **Must be used before the end of the calendar year** (December 24th is our last day open for business).

Pint	\$250 + 50 mem. fee	5%	\$262.50 + \$25 = \$287.50
Quart	\$500 + 50 mem. fee	10%	\$550 + \$25 = \$575.00
Peck	\$750 + 50 mem. fee	15%	\$862.50 + \$25 = \$887.50
Bushel	\$1,000 + 50 mem. fee	20%	\$1,200 + \$25 = \$1,225

II. Hours of Operation

Pick-your-own field will be open Wednesday and Saturday from 9am – 11am (Morning Hours) and from 3pm – 6pm (Evening Hours). During Evening hours, please plan to have your harvesting completed and be checked out by 6pm, since our store closes at this time. Heirloom and Mixed Basket members can place orders or purchase produce anytime during our normal business hours. III. Limitations on Visits

There are no limitations on the number of times you can visit within the hours of operation.

IV. Payment

We accept cash, personal checks made payable to Sansone's Farm Market (include phone number; \$20 charge for returned checks) or Visa, Mastercard and Discover cards. You may mail the sign up form with a check to the address provided, or select the option for us to call you for your credit card information.

V. Membership Cards and Transfer

Membership cards can be picked up at the farm upon your first visit. Harvest and Mixed Basket members must have their membership card present to pick produce from our field. Heirloom and Mixed Basket members will have their pre-paid balance loaded on their membership card, which we will deduct from each time you make a purchase. You may transfer your membership card to another individual and they can take advantage of the pick-your-own option or purchase retail produce using your pre-paid account in your absence. If your card is lost or stolen, please notify us immediately by calling 609-466-1323. We will cancel your current card and issue you a new card with the most recent balance on it.

VI. Availability

Lists will be provided each week in our store and on our website including availability, retail pricing and Member Specials. Availability cannot be guaranteed under stressful weather conditions. Irrigation will be provided and availability controlled to the extent possible. Barring extreme weather conditions, we will not use any fungicide in the field. However, if extreme conditions present themselves, and the alternative is to lose the crop to a disease, fungicide will be used to preserve the crops.

VII. Season

Our season will begin in late April/early May with spring crops, and will continue through the end of October. Availability will change constantly throughout the season.

VIII. Process

- a. **Harvest Members** – Come to our retail store and present your membership card and grab a basket. Head out to the field and pick your produce. Return to the store and we will ring you up. If you do not wish to pick your own produce, you may simply come to our store and purchase produce from our Member Specials. You may also supplement produce you have picked with Member Specials.
- b. **Heirloom and Mixed Basket Members** – Place orders in advance by:
 - 1) Calling 609-466-1323; or
 - 2) Emailing sansonesfarmmarket@gmail.com

The availability list will be posted on our website and in our store. Alternately, you do not need to place an order in advance at all. You may come to our store anytime and pick out items yourself from our insecticide-free produce, Member Specials, or any other products on the farm.

IX. Notes

- a. Harvest membership applies your discount to insecticide-free produce and gives you access to our Member Specials only. All other purchases (conventional produce and other items) will be at regular retail price.
- b. Orders placed by email or phone must be made 24 hours in advance of desired pick up time. Desired pick up time should be included in email.
- c. Harvest Membership is on sale – 25% off if you sign up during the month of January only! You may join at any level of membership anytime during the year. If you become a Harvest Member after Labor Day, it is 50% off for the remainder of the year.
- d. We reserve the right to cancel the program and refund your money in full if the critical level of membership is not reached prior to the start of the season.
